- Third I do hereby commit the tuition and Custody of all my Children unto my said wife Catherine Paul, for and during the time they respectively remain unmarried and under the age of Twenty one year.
- Fourth And last, I do hereby nominate and appoint my said wife Catherine Paul to be the sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.
- In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 26th day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine.
