Item first

I do devise and bequeath to my Children as below named my estate, both real and personal of every name and nature, the same to be equally divided among them, namely One third part to my son John Heidemeyer, One third part to my daughter Doctrea Geis or their heirs. <sup>And</sup> one third part to my Grand Child John Heidemeyer born on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of May A.D. 1864 at Cuyahoga Township Sandusky Co. <sup>the</sup> State of Ohio and being the same a former Child before her marriage of my daughter Barbara, deceased wife of Friedrich Meyer. The division of my said estate shall take place at my decease. A written agreement made between me and my present wife, concerning the stipulation and the partition of our inheritance, and real and personal property, in which agreement each of us as husband and wife, separated its share shall not be affected, and to be and remain in full force. Dated Sandusky Ohio, this 14<sup>th</sup> January 1875.


